

# Sermon Discussion Guide 10/14-10/20 VGroup Meetings

Sermon Title: Always Present - Joshua 1:1-6

Distribute name tags as people enter. Take attendance / collect new guest information including address, phone & email, etc. Allow folks to mingle, fellowship, and settle in with each other.

**Creating Comfort Tip:** Make sure that everyone is familiar with the home you are meeting in. Meaning, they know where the restroom is and cups for a drink should they need one during your time.

Open the session with prayer.

Discussion Starter/Ice Breaker: (15-20 mins)

Fun Insight: What is the one thing you wish you had more time to do/participate in?

Discussion Questions: (30-45 mins)

1. Read Joshua 1:1-6 together. Recap from the sermon: What were the Hebrew people afraid had happened? What did God do?
2. Read the following verses. What do they say about God & His presence in this world? Identify the Lord's action in each passage.
  - a. Gen 28:13-15
  - b. Exodus 3:10-12
  - c. Psalms 23:1-6
  - d. Psalms 139:7-12 & Jer 23:23-24
  - e. Prov 15:3
  - f. Isaiah 41:8-10 & 43:1-5
  - g. Daniel 3:24-27
  - h. Matt 28:19-20
  - i. John 14:16-17
  - j. Acts 18:9-10
3. The Hebrew people felt that without Moses guiding them, God would abandon them and would not care for them. Have you ever felt "apart" from God or scared that you were abandoned? What was the circumstance and how did God reveal Himself to you in that situation? On the other end of the spectrum, have you ever felt God was with you like never before? Explain.
4. After studying God's omniscient character...
  - a. How does this change your view of God?
  - b. How does this affect your circumstances (work, home, relationships etc)?

Closing: Open the floor for discussion / questions.
