

# Sermon Discussion Guide 10/28-11/3 VGroup Meetings

Sermon Title: Always True - Joshua 23:14

Distribute name tags as people enter. Take attendance / collect new guest information including address, phone & email, etc. Allow folks to mingle, fellowship, and settle in with each other.

**Creating Comfort Tip:** Turn on exterior lights prior to your members arriving. With it getting darker earlier, well lit entrances will help people feel welcome.

Open the session with prayer.

Discussion Starter/Ice Breaker: (15-20 mins)

Fun Insight: With Halloween happening this week, ask everyone to reflect on and share a fond memory of trick-or-treating. This could include something from their childhood or something more recent with their children.

Discussion Questions: (30-45 mins)

1. Read Joshua 23:14 together. Recap from the sermon: What are the 3 certainties that confirm God is True that were outlined in the sermon?
2. Read the following verses. Discuss the “eternal” evidence found in each passage.
  - a. Psalms 90:1-3
  - b. Psalms 102:25-27
  - c. John 17:1-5
3. The Bible is filled with people who experience God in a great and very personal way. Let’s look at 3 examples & discuss the experiences.
  - a. Daniel 3:19-26 - Shadrach, Meshach, Abed-nego
  - b. Jonah 1:1-17; 2:1-10; 3:1-3a - Jonah & the whale
  - c. Acts 9:1-22 - Saul’s Conversion
4. God made covenants with those who served Him. We read about His faithful commitment to the covenants. Through these examples we see that God does not change - He is consistent in keeping His promises - He is immutable. Read the following verses & discuss how we see God’s consistency.
  - a. Numbers 23:19-20
  - b. 1 Samuel 15:28-29
  - c. Malachi 3:6
  - d. Hebrews 6:13-20
  - e. Titus 1:1-3
  - f. James 1:16-17
5. Think about a time in life when you recognized God moving or calling you to action & experienced Him in a very personal way. What was/were the circumstance(s)? Did God change in this experience or did He change you through it? Explain.

Closing: Open the floor for discussion / questions.
