

Sermon Discussion Guide 11/11-11/17 VGroup Meetings

Sermon Title: Always Secure John 10:27-30

Distribute name tags as people enter. Take attendance / collect new guest information including address, phone & email, etc. Allow folks to mingle, fellowship, and settle in with each other.

Open the session with prayer.

Discussion Starter/Ice Breaker: (15-20 mins)

Fun Question: If you had a theme song that played every time you walked into a room full of people, what would it be and why?

Discussion Questions: (30-45 mins)

1. Read John 10:27-30 together. Recap from the sermon: What are the core points found in the passage?
2. Read the following verses. How well does God know us? Discuss the evidence found in these verses.
 - a. Genesis 1:26-27
 - b. Psalm 23
 - c. Psalm 100:3
 - d. Psalm 139:1-6; 13-16
 - e. Jeremiah 1:4-5
 - f. Matthew 10:29-31
 - g. John 10:14-15
 - h. Ephesians 2:10
3. What promises of security are found in the following verses? What do you see described as the wrath of God?
 - a. Jeremiah 29:11
 - b. Luke 21:18
 - c. John 3:16-21; 35-36
 - d. John 5:24
 - e. Romans 5:6-11
 - f. 2 Peter 3:8-9
 - g. Revelation 21:6-8
4. Erik spoke about how family cannot be separated - his children are always his children & he is always their father. Study these verses. What do they say about us as God's children? As His children, what is our "inheritance"?
 - a. John 1:12-13
 - b. 1 John 3:1-3
 - c. Revelation 21:7
5. This week we see how we are secure in God. Has there been a time in your life when you have felt insecure? How did God reassure you that you are His?

Closing: Open the floor for discussion / questions.
